

Example Typst Gamebook

This is an example of how to format a Gamebook (like the “Choose Your Own Adventure” books) using Typst. The example text / world is from Zork.

West of House

You are standing in an open field west of a white house, with a boarded front door.

There is a small mailbox here.

To go north, go to page 18.

To go south, go to page 22.

To go west, go to page 4.

Forest

This is a forest, with trees in all directions. To the east, there appears to be sunlight.

To go north, go to page 6.

To go south, go to page 8.

To go east, go to page 14.

Clearing

You are in a clearing, with a forest surrounding you on all sides. A path leads south.

On the ground is a pile of leaves.

To go south, go to page 14.

To go west, go to page 4.

To go east, go to page 10.

Forest

This is a dimly lit forest, with large trees all around.

To go north, go to page 12.

To go west, go to page 4.

Forest

This is a dimly lit forest, with large trees all around.

To go north, go to page 6.

To go south, go to page 12.

To go west, go to page 14.

To go east, go to page 16.

Clearing

You are in a small clearing in a well-marked forest path that extends to the east and west.

To go north, go to page 10.

To go south, go to page 8.

To go west, go to page 20.

To go east, go to page 24.

Forest Path

This is a path winding through a dimly lit forest. The path heads north-south here. One particularly large tree with some low branches stands at the edge of the path.

To go north, go to page 6.

To go west, go to page 4.

To go east, go to page 10.

To go south, go to page 18.

Forest

The forest thins out, revealing impassible mountains.

To continue exploring the forest, go to page 10.

North of House

You are facing the north site of a white house. There is no door here, and all the windows are boarded up. To the north, a narrow path winds through the trees.

To go north, go to page 14.

To go west, go to page 2.

To go east, go to page 20.

Behind House

You are behind the white house. A path leads into the forest to the east. In one corner of the house, there is a small window which is slightly ajar.

To go north, go to page 18.

To go south, go to page 22.

To go east, go to page 12.

South of House

You are facing the south side of a white house. There is no door here, and all the windows are boarded.

To go south, go to page 8.

To go west, go to page 2.

To go east, go to page 20.
